Duties will include, but not limited to; assembly, test, calibration, servicing and repair of a range of electronic and intrinsically safe flow and level measurement instrumentation and associated equipment.

Part of the role will include receiving deliveries into the business from customers, suppliers and internal departments.

Due to the expansion of the business the right candidate will also be involved (where requested) with the development/testing of new products being designed within the business.

- Confident telephone manner as you will be expected to liaise with customers over the phone.
